
Pali is a well known figure in the Santa Barbara art scene, with his work on exhibit in one man and group shows regionally. His paintings and artwork are in private collections and museums in Europe. Pali's inflatables have been commissioned for festivals and special events around the world. Some of the events include the Global Warming Conference in Bali, a commission by the "Tropical Forest Group" of Santa Barbara. His assemblage from recycled materials created for the CAF Black & Orange Bash won the 2005 Grand Prize.

The Inflatables

These wonderful, whimsical art sculptures are filled with air not helium, and run on an air blower that plugs into a regular 110 outlet or can also be used with a battery for power. They are large and on the average ranging around 25' in diameter and about 24' tall. Many of Pali's inflatables have the rings for aerialists to attach their silks for aerial performances.

The Inflatables can be lit from inside and outside and make a very dynamic presence, day or night. They are easy to install as they are made of fabric and un-inflated they are about 3' by 3'. They require two people for the installation and are easily taken down by deflating them using the large zippers. They can be used inside or outside in wind less than 15 miles per hour. They cannot be used in the rain as it can cause mildew to form on the cloth.
